VILLAGERS GAIN NEW SKILLS!

During 2007/08 KIDS FOR KIDS has extended its assistance to an additional 10 villages covering 23,385 people in 4,000 households whilst also continuing to provide support to the existing 29 KIDS FOR KIDS villages.

Meetings were held to ensure that the communities understood and embraced the underlying philosophy of self reliance and sustainability. Two key village based institutions were created, a Village Development Committee which guides the direction of development and monitors the progress of activities, and the Animal Loans Committee, responsible for running the animal loans scheme, including selection of the beneficiaries. Each committee elects its own Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

Our new Animal Husbandry Course, which takes place in the villages, has proved really successful. A vet from the State Ministry of Animal Resources and a range technician from the Pastureland and Range Department have trained 397 goat loan beneficiaries, including young shepherds, 78 members of the committees and 16 paravets so far this year.

During the training children of beneficiary families, who play a large part in the daily care of them, learnt how to detect the early signs of the onset of disease. A Children's Animal Loans Committee has also been formed in each village and members are responsible for checking the animals on a weekly basis and reporting any problems to the ALC and the paravet. 19 paravets from 15 villages returned from training recently with their starter kits and donkeys to enable them to reach their clients more readily. Veterinary revolving drugs funds have been established in the new villages to ensure that the farmers have ready access to the necessary treatments for their animals.

In February KIDS FOR KIDS, in partnership with UN FAO, helped vaccinate 24,854 animals and our paravets treated 1439 animals. We provided 1910 nanny goats and 134 really good billy goats to families, and 404 donkeys are with their new families! We are also delighted that 1500 mothers have 2 blankets each for their

children, plus 2212 now have a mosquito net - basic essentials that it is difficult imagining a family unable to afford, yet where the majority of families are so poor they have no chance of owning any. 130,000 tree seedlings survived the floods in the autumn and are growing well, and we have already planted a further 80,000 this year! We are proud to announce that 12 midwives graduated successfully in April and are now at work in their villages!

Finally our Trustees organised a delivery of life saving medical equipment to the hospital at Mellit during their Spring visit to Darfur.
