



Kids for Kids 2018 Harvest Appeal

Currently in the UK we are waiting to see if the extended dry spell followed by heavy and sometimes destructive rain has had an impact on UK crops, ahead of our usually abundant Harvest. However, at the same time there are thousands of families in Darfur, Sudan, for whom this time of year is *always* known as ‘**The Hungry Months**’.



Right now, the situation for families in Darfur is even worse than usual because they have already been facing famine for many months, since the harvest failed last year. And while, thankfully, the rains have now started in Sudan, many had no choice other than to eat the seeds they would usually have kept for planting and so are in danger of having nothing next harvest either.

In England we no longer rely on the harvest to feed ourselves. Whatever the outcome from our Summer, the impact will not be too great for most people. But in Darfur, no crops can mean starvation. This is why Kids for Kids is holding a **Harvest Appeal**.

Please would your School consider holding a Service, Collection or Harvest Supper this season in aid of Darfur?

Whilst we are celebrating our harvests, we must be sure to pray and offer support for those who are less fortunate than ourselves. Your support will mean we can provide those at greatest risk with 90 kilos of sorghum flour to prevent starvation until families can harvest a crop, 15 kilos of ground nuts to feed their animals, a goat to give milk for life-saving nutrition to children, plus a sack of seed for planting to ensure a bountiful harvest.

We are not an Aid Agency, but with no other organisations helping in the remote villages, we have to take action. Together, we can make a real impact on the lives of the children in Darfur now, helping them to survive these ‘hungry months’ and to thrive in the years to come.
