For over 22 years, our sustainable projects have been transforming the lives of hundreds of children in one of the most challenging regions of the world, in the most isolated and deprived villages in Darfur, Sudan. We started by introducing goats for their protein-rich milk, and hand-pumps for clean water. Our projects are based on training the communities to run the projects themselves and as well as an integrated package of grassroots initiatives – farm tools, mosquito nets, blankets, donkeys, seeds and more - we now provide health care with trained midwives, first aiders & medical drugs, as well



as veterinary care for all the animals in each village. Our kindergartens give children a future out of poverty.

At the same time, the trees we plant -59,000 so far - are helping to tackle climate change in a region at the forefront of global warming. Animals and birds are returning to our community forests. On our last visit, we were delighted to spot 2 Hornbill in our trees. Wildlife is returning to Darfur.

Kids for Kids was founded in 2001 by Patricia Parker OBE and has received support from many well-known personalities including HRH King Charles III, Dame Joanna Lumley KCMG FRGS, Miriam Margolyes OBE, His Holiness Pope Francis, Quentin Blake CBE, Michael Bond OBE, Philip Treacy OBE and many others.
