To help tackle Climate Change Kids for Kids are planting TREES!



Kids for Kids has been planting trees in Darfur since 2007 when we reintroduced the Baobab tree to North Darfur. Since then we have planted over 53,000 tree seedlings in remote villages, turning the desert green. As part of our policy of providing projects that help families long term, we are planting trees to help stabilise the deserts of Darfur, creating a microclimate and reducing the rate at which the Sahara is creeping south.

We need your support to plant trees for three community forests and individual trees outside huts and kindergartens in our 105 villages to help improve the lives of children struggling to survive in one of the most deprived regions of the world.

## What sort of trees do we plant?

Kids for Kids plants over 14 different varieties of trees in Darfur including Neem, Moringa, Baobab, Nabuk, Citrus Fruit Trees, and Acacia Senegal. These provide important by-products that we teach people to use, help to reforest the desert, give fruit to hungry children and provide shade from the hot desert sun. Most important of all, they stabilise the sand and create a mini climate. Birds and animals are returning to the community forests we have already planted.
