This year we have seen immense hardship here in the UK. It is a struggle for millions of families across the UK who have been worrying about keeping a roof over their heads and food on the table. **In Darfur, Sudan, however, things have been even worse. Children need our help.** Violence has gripped the country, leaving millions displaced and injured without any access to food and healthcare.



Bombing continues across the capital with no regard for civilians. The future must be terrifying for them. In the capital soldiers have looted houses and taken them over. People have lost everything. In Darfur over two and a half million people have already fled the country, with more each day. Hospitals are virtually unable to function. What little food there is, is costing 500 times more than it did a few weeks ago. Normal life has not just been disrupted but destroyed.

The rainy season which started this month poses its own challenges. Flash flooding often sweeps away whole fields of crops – the only food families have to eat. Many will not be able to plant their fields because it is too dangerous.

People need our help now. Whilst we celebrate Harvest, they face starvation. In Darfur, no crops mean no food. Children are hungry.

What we can do to help – Kids for Kids is providing emergency food and essentials right now to families unable to support themselves.
